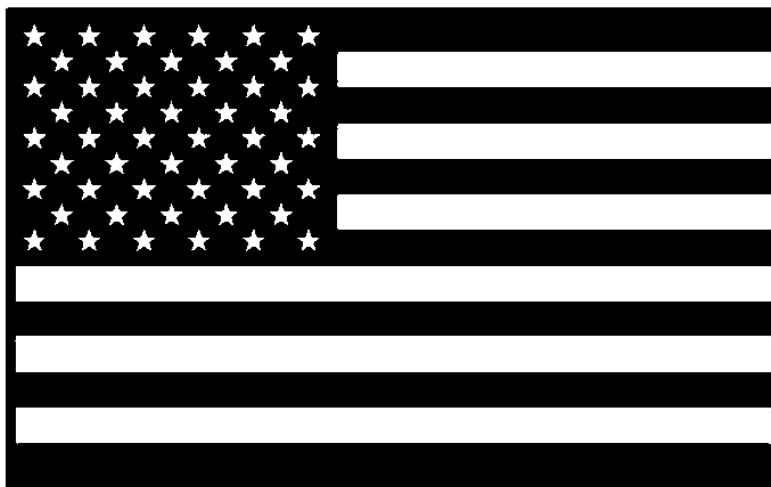

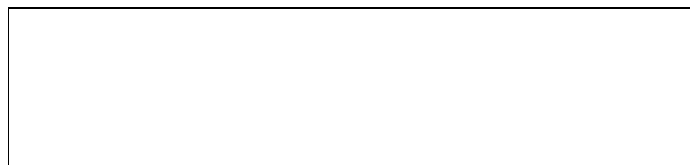
OUR EDITORIAL POLICY

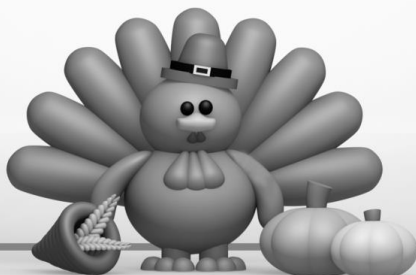

THANKSGIVING FUN FACTS

Franklin D. Roosevelt once changed the date of Thanksgiving up a week in 1939 to extend the holiday shopping season during the Great Depression.

The first TV dinner was inspired by Thanksgiving leftovers.

There's a Guinness World Record for the most people dressed as turkeys. I swear! In Dallas, Texas, 661 people gathered dressed as turkeys in 2011.

Santa Claus has been a part of the Thanksgiving parade since the beginning. The Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade concludes with Santa Claus to kick off the holiday season, blending the spirit of Thanksgiving with the anticipation of Christmas.

The first Turkey Trot race was held in Buffalo, New York, in 1896.

Not everyone in North America celebrates Thanksgiving in November. Our neighbors in Canada celebrate Thanksgiving on the second Monday in October, and Norfolk Island observes it on the last Wednesday of November.

The tradition of breaking the wishbone is actually ancient. The practice dates back to the Etruscans of 322 B.C., who believed birds could predict the future. The wishbone, or "furcula," was considered sacred.

The Turkey was almost the national bird. Benjamin Franklin had a soft spot for turkey feathers and proposed the turkey as the national bird.
