Contract 2021

I am proud to say that the last Contract/CIPP meetings at the Union Hall on April 22nd were the best yet. We had great participation and a lot of great questions asked. We will be having more as we move closer to the Contract and after, watch the handbills for dates and times to be announced.

Profit Sharing

The Company put out talking points to our members regarding profit sharing and how good it has been to them over the last few years. Walter Reuther once predicted companies would do exactly that. In January of 1958, after the UAW Bargaining Convention first raised the idea of workers sharing in the profits their labor generates, Reuther appeared on the Mike Wallace Interview. Discussing the idea of future negotiations, Reuther said of corporate executives: "A few years from now, they'll be bragging about this, just as they brag about the pension plans they didn't want to give us, just as they brag about the other things they gave us at the bargaining table only after we fought for them. I predict they'll talk about this one of these days in glowing terms."

Education and Skilled Trades Scholarships of \$1,000 for your Post-secondary Education The Dubuque Area Labor-Management Council (DALMC) board and

The Dubuque Area Labor-Management Council (DALMC) board and scholarship committee has opened a second round of scholarships. This gives you a chance to apply for a scholarship for the 2021-2022 school year. The DALMC will be awarding up to \$5,000 in scholarships.

The scholarship is open until Friday, May 14th. Applications can be picked up at the Union Hall or visit <u>Dubuque Area Labor-Management Council's website</u> for an application and criteria. First and second round applications will be accepted. Applications are due May 14, 2021.

Unemployment Benefits

The Republican-led Iowa Senate will soon be voting on a bill that will affect your unemployment benefits. This bill, SSB1172, takes away your benefits for the first week of unemployment, reduces benefits for individuals with 3 or more dependents, and eliminates the 13-week extension due to plant closing, among other things. Please go to www.legis.iowa.gov to see this bill and contact your representatives in Des Moines to let them know you oppose losing unemployment benefits.
