ROOM RATES AND RESERVATIONS - Anyone interested in finding a roommate to share room costs should contact the National CLUW office. We will assist in making those connections. Hotel room rates are \$175.00 per day for single and doubles, \$195.00 for triples, and \$215.00 for quads plus current taxes of 14.025%. Rate is available 3 days before and after the convention, based on availability for all guest rooms. Reservation deadline is <u>October 1, 2023. Hotel check-in time is 3 PM and</u> <u>check-out time is 11 AM.</u>

Make hotel reservation <u>online</u> through the link at <u>www.cluw.org</u> or by calling the Reservation Office at **1-888-933-5363** and providing the <u>Group code</u>: "CLU". No group code is needed for online reservations. You can make online reservations at: https://book.passkey.com/go/CLUWconvention2023. Special needs related to hotel accommodations should be discussed directly with the hotel when you make your reservation. All reservations must be accompanied by a first night room deposit or guaranteed by a major credit card. All deposits are refundable with a 24 hour advance notice to the hotel.

### **Early Departure Fee**

If a guest who has requested a room within the Room Block checks out prior to the guest's reserved checkout date, the Hotel will add an early checkout fee to that guest's individual account (currently, one night's room and tax. Guests wishing to avoid an early checkout fee should advise the Hotel at or before check-in of any change in planned length of stay.

### Transportation:

From MSP Airport to hotel (Approximately 12 miles away)

- Blue Line Light Rail: Roughly about \$5 one way ticket, light rail station picks up from both Terminal 1 and Terminal 2, and the exit in downtown would be the Nicollet Mall Station. The light rail station is about 6 blocks from the hotel, which may require a taxi/Lyft/Uber to get to the hotel.
- Uber/Lyft: Prices vary, but typically about \$25-\$30

### Transportation to Mall of America

- Blue Line Light Rail: Nicollet Mall Station, blue line to MOA, stop is just past the airport.
