ROOM RATES AND RESERVATIONS - *Anyone interested in finding a roommate to share room costs should contact the National CLUW office. We will assist in making those connections.* Hotel room rates are \$175.00 per day for single and doubles, \$195.00 for triples, and \$215.00 for quads plus current taxes of 14.025%. Rate is available 3 days before and after the convention, based on availability for all guest rooms. Reservation deadline is **October 1, 2023. Hotel check-in time is 3 PM and check-out time is 11 AM.**

All reservations must be accompanied by a first night room deposit or guaranteed by a major credit card. All deposits are refundable with a 24 hour advance notice to the hotel.

Early Departure Fee

If a guest who has requested a room within the Room Block checks out prior to the guest's reserved checkout date, the Hotel will add an early checkout fee to that guest's individual account (currently, one night's room and tax. Guests wishing to avoid an early checkout fee should advise the Hotel at or before check-in of any change in planned length of stay.
