Dear Brothers and Sisters:

Region 4 UAW will hold its *Chaplaincy Conference*, including workshops on how to incorporate chaplaincy in the workplace and in our daily lives. Registration will be limited to 135 people.

This conference will be held August 27th through August 31, 2023, at the Pat Greathouse Center located at 1000 E. Center Street, Ottawa, IL 61350. It will begin at 9:00 AM on Monday the 28th and end by 1:00 PM on Thursday, the 31st. Sunday, August 27th will serve as a travel day.

Despite what its name suggests, the Chaplaincy program is inclusive and open to members of all faiths, so all members are encouraged to attend in addition to local chaplains. Chaplains work to assist members through challenging times and may also do so in conjunction with EAP (Employee Assistance Program) representatives at some worksites.

REGISTRATION: Registration for this conference will take place at <https://conference.uaw.org/region4/cpc.php>. **This link will go live on June 28, 2023, and will close on August 15, 2023.** The username is 2023region4 and the password is registerCPC. However, at this time, the registration fee and PGC lodging cost (if applicable) will still need to be mailed to the Region 4 Subregional Office in Hazelwood. Instructions on how to best use this system is listed below.

1. If you plan on lodging at the PGC, please call Jetta at (314) 731-2800 for reservation/confirmation number first. If you will not be lodging at the PGC, proceed to Step 2.
2. Register at <https://conference.uaw.org/region4/cpc.php> and enter your PGC lodging confirmation number (if applicable).
3. Mail applicable fees to the address listed below.

Note to Financial Secretaries: Checks should be made payable to "UAW Region 4 Activity Fund" and the notation part of the check should mention "Chaplaincy Conference."

Financial Assistance: Scholarships are being offered by the UAW Region 4 Retired Workers, which will provide up to \$1,000 for each member attending. This covers registration, lodging, and the remainder will help offset mileage or lost time. To be considered for financial assistance, locals must make a written request to me and attach their last three (3) monthly financial statements.

Meals: The first provided meal will be breakfast on Monday and the last will be breakfast on Thursday.

Lodging: Rooms at the Pat Greathouse Center are available at \$70.00 per room, per night. Each room has two (2) beds; we urge members to double-up, when feasible, to ensure that as many delegates possible can stay on the property. Please contact Jetta at (314) 731-2800 to make room reservations for the Center.

If you get the office voicemail, please leave a message with your request and your email address for confirmation and/or follow-up.

You will be emailed a confirmation number once your reservation has been received. When making reservations, please indicate if the delegate(s) has special room requirements (PGC management will not change rooms during the check-in process).

PGC Hotel check-in will begin on Sunday, August 27th at 3:00 p.m. Check-out will be by 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 31, 2023.

It is imperative to fill the hotel rooms at the PGC, before seeking area lodging. However, in the event rooms at the PGC become sold out, we also have negotiated rates at the Comfort Inn (815-433-0029), Fairfield Inn (815-431-8955), the Hampton Inn (815-434-6040) and the Super 8 Motel (815-434-2888). Ask for the UAW rate – All rates are subject to availability.

In following the Region 4 UAW Bylaws of the UAW Region 4 Chaplaincy Council, Article V, Sec. 3, we will be holding an election for the position of Member-at-Large at the Region 4 Chaplaincy Conference held August 28-31, 2023.

Region 4 delegates interested in running for this position will need a letter of approval from their local union and must be in good standing.

The election will be conducted per the provisions of the International Union, UAW Constitution and UAW Region 4 Chaplaincy Council Bylaws.

The term of office shall be for three (3) years.

Voting shall be by secret ballot and winners will be determined by a plurality vote of the delegates present. Only those serving as official paid delegates to the conference are eligible to vote.
