To begin I'd like to address some issues occurring with Advanced Radiology and their network status with UnitedHealthcare. I have had a few calls about members receiving bills from Advanced Radiology after having lab work or imaging done. From what I was told the contract for Advanced Radiology and UnitedHealthcare expired on January 1st, 2022, however, Advanced Radiology signed a new contract under a new NPI number. It seems there has been some confusion when processing the claims as to which NPI number to use, the old one or the new one. When the old NPI number is used the claims are denied as out-of-network and the provider then bills the member. If you have received a bill from Advanced Radiology due to it being out-of-network, please contact me or come see me at the Union Hall and I will assist you in resolving the issue.

Don't forget to get your annual wellness exam completed by August 31st to qualify for the \$125 Wellness Incentive to be paid out in December.

I'd like to conclude with encouraging all members, new or established, to attend the monthly membership meetings. These meetings are the place that the Local conducts our business.
