# President's Report

I hope everyone enjoyed the Labor Day Holiday and a big "Thank You!" to those of you who participated in the Labor Day Parade. It was a great turnout for parade entries as well as parade goers. It's always good to see the community support that labor in the Quad Cities receives. The East Moline Labor Day Parade is the only labor-organized parade in the area, thanks to the Quad City Federation of Labor which has been organizing and running this parade for the last 40 years. It's great to the see the labor organizations of the QC area come together and display their pride in what they do.

<u>All active employees</u> should have received, in the mail, the letter explaining how to qualify for the next Wellness Incentive. If you receive your flu vaccination between September 1<sup>st</sup> and December 31<sup>st</sup> of this year, you will receive a \$125 incentive on your paycheck in December of 2024. As for the Wellness Incentive for this past year, if you had your annual wellness exam between September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 and August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023, you will receive a \$125 incentive on your paycheck in December of this year.

Another note of interest for active employees is the "General Wage Increase" of 5% that will become effective on October 2<sup>nd</sup> of this year. Any hours worked that week would reflect the wage increase on the following weeks paycheck. With this GWI added to the initial 10% GWI in November of 2021 and the approximate 10.5% COLA increases throughout the life of the contract to this point, it will reflect an approximate 25.5% increase in wages since the start of the current contract.

On the <u>retiree</u> side of the healthcare, I was recently informed by the Company that any <u>Pre-'97 retiree</u> on the Medicare Advantage Plan can go to the Mayo Clinic and it will be covered as in-network. This is a new development as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of this year. As always, please contact UnitedHealthcare to ensure that any doctor, procedure, or facility you are going to will be covered at the in-network level, prior to your visit.


