ARTICLE V VOTING DELEGATES

Section 1. The nomination and election of Officers and four (4) Executive Board Membersat-Large and the adoption or amendment of By-Laws necessary to govern the STATE CAP shall be restricted to the following delegates:

- A. Local Union Presidents
- B. Local Union Vice-Presidents
- C. Local Union Recording Secretaries
- D. Local Union Financial Secretaries

ARTICLE VI

VOTING STRENGTH

<u>Section 1.</u> The Local Unions shall be allotted a voting strength for all elections and the adoption or amendment of By-Laws based on their average Local Union Per Capital Tax paid to the STATE CAP in the last six months available immediately preceding the Spring STATE CAP Conference.

<u>Section2.</u> The Voting Strength of each Local Union, as per Section 1 of this Article, shall be divided amongst the delegates as per Article V, Section 1; however, one delegate from a Local Union may vote the total voting strength of his Local Union.

<u>Section 3.</u> All votes, other than roll call votes for the election of Officers and four (4) Executive Board Members-at-Large and adoption or amendment of By-Laws, shall be on the basis of one vote per delegate.

<u>Section 4.</u> The Director of Region 4 UAW and all International Representatives, assigned to and regularly working in the State of Wisconsin, shall have voice but no vote.

<u>Section 5.</u> All Local Unions shall be allotted a Voting Strength for all elections and the adoption or amendments of By-Laws in accordance with this ARTICLE VI, Sections 1 and 2, in all Area CAP's in Wisconsin.
