This conference is designed to assist in cultivating leaders.

Workshops covered will teach us the core values of our Union that still guide us today. We will learn skills to run effective union meetings and learn the difference of the Roles of our Officers. We have a variety of plenaries discussing important topics from Contract Campaigns to instructions on how to use our Constitution. We will also discuss what it takes to develop a Unionist.

We will be holding a new workshop that is meant to lead members to action, Festivus. Delegates should bring an "Ugly Christmas Sweater" to wear during Festivus. We will be celebrating Christmas in July and will host an ugly Christmas sweater contest.

This conference is different from the previous conference, "Basic Summer School" where we will focus on educating new members or members that are getting involved. Also important to note, you may consider staying over for the Region 4 Charity Golf Outing to be held on July 26th.

We anticipate this class will fill up quicky, and those responding earliest with completed registration and non-refundable fees will have the best chance of being accepted before we reach capacity. Local Unions should select alternates in the event a delegate cancels at the last minute. Rather than an expense, these weeks should be considered an investment in the future of your local union.
