It is important to note that only duly registered delegates will be allowed to vote at the Regional and State elections.

Election Notice

Article VII

Elections and Terms of Office

- Section 1 Elected officers will hold offices for a period of three (3) years. All elections will be by secret ballot and be conducted by an election committee of at least two members that are not running for any office. Nominations for any election will be the first order of business after the opening ceremonies of the conference with the actual election to be held the last day of the conference.
- Section 2 Officers will take office at the conclusion of the Regional Conference with all records and files turned over to the newly elected officers to ensure a smooth transition.
- Section 3 When a vacancy occurs on or after six months before the date upon which the regular elections are to be held, no election shall take place to fill such vacancy and said office shall remain vacant until filled at the following regular scheduled election.
 - a. State or Regional Officers will make an appointment of vacant seat until the next State or Regional election is held.
- Section 4 During any Region 4 Veterans elections, there will be no campaign literature, signs, or buttons within one hundred (100) feet of any polling place during the elections. The election committee will ensure this by-law will be enforced.


