We have some updates on the plant-

**Stamping**-The team has been in stamping working on the presses. This will lead to a health assessment on the equipment out there to see what still works and what needs to be replaced.

**Trades**-A month or so ago, 25 trades were requested for the plant to work on some pull ahead items that could be done while waiting on the retool to start. This request is sitting at the last step in the process for approval.

**Launch Agreement**-The company has reached out to us on a launch agreement. We will be meeting with them on May 6th. The fact that a meeting has been set for this discussion is good news for the status of the plant.

**International/Corp visit**-Tomorrow, VP Boyer and his team will be at the plant along with a team from Corporate. This is supposed to be a walk-through of the facility with no announcements expected. If any information is received from this visit, I'll update everyone with the information.
