- Event Check-In: Monday, August 31st from 3 - 4:30pm. **There will be a mandatory opening meeting at 4:30pm in the Education building.**
- Event Opens: Monday, August 31st at 4:30pm
- Event Adjourns: Friday, September 4th at 1pm (PGC Hotel guests should check out by 10am)
- Travel Day: Friday, September 4th

HOTEL RESERVATIONS: *NO PETS ARE ALLOWED*

- PGC hotel rooms will be available on a first come, first served basis for \$70 nightly.
- Each room has two beds. We encourage double occupancy whenever possible.
- PGC Hotel check-in begins: Monday, August 31st at 3pm. Check-out: 10am Friday, September 4th.

- We **STRONGLY** encourage avoiding the Holiday Inn as it was built by non-union labor.

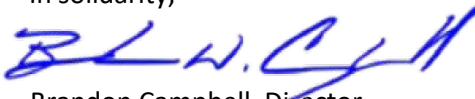
