Clarification on the new SUB process

There's some bad information being put out to some members. This new sub process will not allow you to quit your job and just collect full sub pay. If you quit or get fired, you will open an unemployment claim. If unemployment denies your claim due to the quit or termination, your sub pay will be reduced by the amount unemployment would have paid you had it been approved. The company still has the right to reduce their responsibility in how much they have to pay you in sub if you are paid or denied benefits by unemployment.

If you are working, or intend on getting a job and find that you don't like it. Don't just quit the job, try and find something else before quitting.

***This new sub process has not started yet. When I get the new process laid out for me and notified when it will start, I will get this information out to everyone.

We have members that haven't collected sub this entire time due to the amount they are making at their job. If this is you, or you know someone in this position, please tell them to reach out to us. We can walk them through the process. There's no one here on layoff who shouldn't be receiving sub once the new process starts.
