Online Conference Registration

Registration for the 2024 National CAP Conference as well as hotel accommodations MUST be done online. Your registration should be completed by **Tuesday**, **January 2**, **2024**. Your \$325 National CAP Conference registration fee has been prepaid, and your credentials will be available for your pick-up at the CAP Registration area. **Unlike past years**, the UAW will not be able to accommodate members' guests, including spouses, partners, and/or companions.

Hotel Accommodations

Staff and delegates MUST also book your hotel accommodations for the Marriott Marquis through the above website. All staff and delegates must book their own rooms. The Housing for Retired Workers delegates will be paid through the UAW Retired Workers Department. Staff should use their UAW issued credit cards. You must notify the Retired Workers Department immediately if your travel plans have changed. The hotel will bill the department if your room reservation is not cancelled in advance and this bill will be passed to you. If driving, self-parking will be master billed; however, you will be responsible for any valet parking charges. Incidentals are at your own expense. Handicap rooms are available, so please indicate that when making your reservation. Cut-off date for reservations is January 3, 2024. Please verify your total room charges upon checkout and be sure to get a copy of your bill for your expenses.

Air Travel Information

To make airline reservations, call TSI at 1-866-397-0667 by January 2, 2024, to insure the lowest airfares possible. Your airfare will be billed directly to the UAW Retired Workers Department. You must accept the lowest airfare according to the UAW travel guidelines. **Staff should make flight arrangements through Concur.**

In keeping with UAW policy, all Retired Workers delegates residing within 300 miles of Washington, DC should drive, and their mileage expenses should be submitted to the UAW Retired Workers Department for reimbursement. Please call if you have any questions regarding the UAW travel policy.

All meeting attendees should send their request for expense reimbursement and necessary receipts to the Retired Workers Department for payment. Your per diem will be paid as follows when you submit your meeting expenses to our department:

Tuesday, January 23 \$0.00 (\$55.00 minus Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner)

Wednesday, January 24 \$29.00 (\$55.00 minus Breakfast and Lunch)
