We wish to call your attention to Article II, Paragraph 2 and Article III, Paragraph 3 of the UAW National General Motors Council Bylaws:

## ARTICLE II

### Current Language

2. There shall be five UAW National General Motors Subcouncils. These Subcouncils shall be organized on the basis of common interest of the members involved and a Local or Unit shall have representation in Subcouncils in accordance with the attached charts. The Subcouncils are as follows:
  1. CCA
  2. GMVM (Car & Truck), Salaried and Medical
  3. GMPT & Foundry, GMCH, Die Cast, Salaried and Medical
  4. Stamping
  5. Skilled Tool and Die, Design, Engineering, Model Maker, Pattern Shop and Maintenance

### Proposed Language

2. There shall be five UAW National General Motors Subcouncils. These Subcouncils shall be organized on the basis of common interest of the members involved and a Local or Unit shall have representation in Subcouncils in accordance with the attached charts. The Subcouncils are as follows:
  1. CCA
  2. GMVM (Car & Truck), Salaried and Medical
  3. GMPT & Foundry, GMCH, Die Cast, ~~Salaried and Medical~~
  4. Stamping
  5. Skilled Tool and Die, Design, Engineering, Model Maker, Pattern Shop and Maintenance

## ARTICLE III

### Current Language

1. The UAW National General Motors Negotiating Committee shall consist of one member from Subcouncils 1 and 4, two members from Subcouncil 2, and four members from Subcouncil 3. In Subcouncil 5 the members will be elected as follows: One member from Tool and Die, Design, Engineering, Model Maker, Pattern Shop classifications and one member from the Maintenance classifications.

### Proposed Language

1. The UAW National General Motors Negotiating Committee shall consist of one member from Subcouncils 1 and 4, **and** two members from Subcouncils 2 **and** 3. In Subcouncil 5 the members will be elected as follows: One member from Tool and Die, Design, Engineering, Model Maker, Pattern Shop classifications and one member from the Maintenance classifications.

### Current Language

3. Subcouncils 1 and 4 shall elect one member and one alternate member to the National Negotiating Committee. Subcouncil 2 shall elect two members and two alternate members to the National Negotiating Committee. Subcouncil 3 shall elect four members and four alternate members to the National Negotiating Committee. Subcouncil 5 shall elect one member and one alternate member from Tool and Die, Design, Engineering, Model Maker, Pattern Shop classifications and one member and one alternate member from the Maintenance classifications to the National Negotiating Committee. This election shall take place at a meeting scheduled pursuant to Article II Section 10 sufficiently in advance of the opening of negotiations to permit time for the necessary preparation for negotiations by the National Negotiating Committee, as determined by the General Motors Department Director in consultation with the Subcouncil Chairpersons. The term of office for members and alternate members of the National Negotiating Committee shall be for the period of negotiations of a new national contract and until the Subcouncil meetings scheduled prior to and in the year in which the next national negotiations for a new contract are to take place as required above. The alternate member of the National Negotiating Committee shall serve when the elected member is unable to participate.

### Proposed Language

3. Subcouncils 1 and 4 shall elect one member and one alternate member to the National Negotiating Committee. Subcouncils 2 **and** 3 shall elect two members and two alternate members to the National Negotiating Committee. Subcouncil 5 shall elect one member and one alternate member from Tool and Die, Design, Engineering, Model Maker, Pattern Shop classifications and one member and one alternate member from the Maintenance classifications to the National Negotiating Committee. This election shall take place at a meeting scheduled pursuant to Article II Section 10 sufficiently in advance of the opening of negotiations to permit time for the necessary preparation for negotiations by the National Negotiating Committee, as determined by the General Motors Department Director in consultation with the Subcouncil Chairpersons. The term of office for members and alternate members of the National Negotiating Committee shall be for the period of negotiations of a new national contract and until the Subcouncil meetings scheduled prior to and **in the year prior to** national negotiations for a new contract are to take place as required above. The alternate member of the National Negotiating Committee shall serve when the elected member is unable to participate.
