Dear Brothers and Sisters:

A meeting of the Region 4 Retired Workers Council Board is scheduled for October 11-13, 2021, at the Pat Greathouse Education Center in Ottawa, Illinois. As it relates to COVID-19, we will continue to adhere to the guidance provided by the CDC, state, and local officials. Officers should arrive by 1:00 PM for a meeting on Monday, October 11th. All other delegates should arrive *no earlier* than 3:00 PM for hotel check-in and conference registration. We will depart on Wednesday, October 13th after breakfast.

An Election of the Region 4 Retired Workers Council Board will be held on Tuesday, October 12th at 9:00 AM at the Pat Greathouse Center in Ottawa, IL.

In accordance with Article 55, Section 3b of the International Constitution, entitled "Retirees" and the Retired Workers Council By-Laws, all delegates who are elected by each chapter and/or area council, local union president or designated by the local union president to be the local's designated representative will elect a new Retired Workers Council Board. Please refer to pages 2 and 3 of this letter for more important election information.

As you may be aware, we took action at the August Region 4 UAW Retired Workers Council Board Meeting to add members to this Council from the states that merged into Region 4 in March of 2021, namely Kansas and Missouri. Delegates from these states will be elected on October 12th in accordance with the Region 4 UAW Retired Workers Council By-Laws.

Registration Fee: There will be a registration fee of \$50.00 per delegate. By October 1st, please send your registration fee, along with the enclosed delegate registration form to:

Note: All miscellaneous expenses will be the responsibility of the Council Member or Chapter.

The Region 4 Retired Workers Fund will pay for your single or double lodging for the nights of October 11th and October 12th. **Please call Tamara at (815) 433-2500 for a room reservation no later than Friday, September 24, 2021.**

Attention all Invitees: Please report to the PGC Hotel to be notified of your room assignment. We will fill the Pat Greathouse Center Hotel before assigning *anyone* to other area hotels. If there is a need to utilize outside lodging, officers may be housed at the Super 8 – Ottawa or other area hotel. Rooms will be assigned on a first-come-first-serve basis. *Single delegates may be expected to share a room with another single delegate.*

The Region 4 Retired Workers Fund will pay for:

1. Single or double room lodging for two (2) nights – October 11th and October 12th.
2. Mileage at .50¢ per mile (**driver only**). Car-pooling is mandatory.

Since the following meals will be provided, there will be **no per diem allowed:**

- Monday, October 11th – Dinner
- Tuesday, October 12th – Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner
- Wednesday, October 13th – Breakfast

Election Guidelines:

1. A total of 76 Board members will be elected – 11 Executive Board officers and 64 Board Members-at-Large and 1 Advisory Council members.
2. The following eleven (11) Executive Board Officers will be elected: Chairperson, 1st Vice-Chairperson, 2nd Vice-Chairperson, 3rd Vice-Chairperson, Recording Secretary, Financial Secretary, three (3) trustees, Sergeant-at-Arms and Guide.
3. Sixty-four (64) Board Members-at-Large will be elected.
4. Three (3) alternates to the Board will be elected.
5. Only certified delegates are eligible to vote and be candidates for the Region 4 Retired Workers Council Board.

Please send a list of all elected delegates to me by October 4, 2021, so I can furnish this information to the credentials committee in time for this meeting.

Also, enclosed is a report of all chapters in Region 4 and their retiree totals.

Example: Retiree Chapter 94 has a membership of 2,415. They would be allowed 1 delegate for the local union president, 1 for the chapter and 2 additional delegates for each 1,000 members for a total of 4.

Retiree Chapter 1304 has a membership of 1,504. They would be allowed no delegate for president (closed local), 1 for the chapter and 1 for the additional 1,000 members for a total of 2.


Area Councils can elect 3 delegates each.

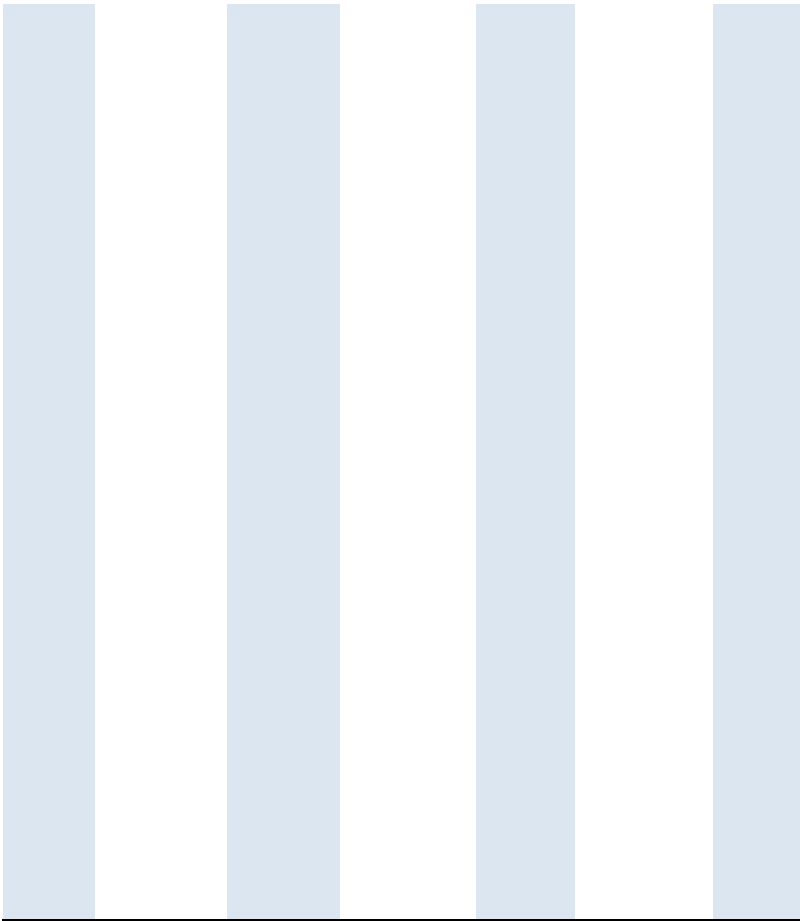

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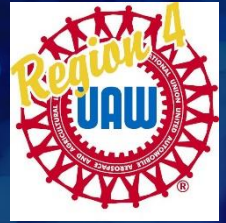
