RE: 2020 UAW Voluntary Community Action Program (V-CAP) Dollar Drive

Greetings:

It is time to kick off our annual UAW V-CAP Dollar Drive for 2020. The money raised last year was used to help support candidates who care about our active and retired member's needs. Now it is time to continue our efforts and prepare for future elections.

The 2020 V-CAP Dollar Drive Raffle Drawings will be held during the Fall Leadership Conference on October 3, 2020 at the UAW Pat Greathouse Educational Center, 1000 East Center Street, Ottawa, Illinois.

- Each Local Union Financial Secretary will find V-CAP drive flyers and four forms enclosed, with instructions, which need to be used for recordkeeping for this year's UAW V-CAP Dollar Drive.
- The single-stub tickets are in books of five, \$2 per ticket. Members enrolled in automatic V-CAP check-off deductions will have one ticket printed for each two dollars they contribute. Their ticket will be entered in the October 3rd V-CAP Raffle Drawing. **All local and area CAP raffle drawings must take place prior to the Region 4 V-CAP Raffle Drawings.** The four prizes for the raffle drawings are:

1st Grand Prize - \$8,000 or vacation cruise voucher for equal value

2nd - \$4,000

3rd - \$2,000

4th - \$1,000

- All monies collected should be deposited weekly into the local union's bank account and logged into its books. A check should be made payable to **"UAW V-CAP"** and mailed to **Andrea's attention at the Region 4 office at 680 Barclay Blvd., Lincolnshire, IL 60069.** Please be advised, no cash will be accepted from any Local Union.

- September 14, 2020 is the deadline to submit checks from the ticket sales, return used and unused tickets to Andrea at the regional office. *V-CAP ticket sales checks submitted after September 21, 2020 will go toward next year's dollar drive raffle drawings.*

If any local union uses its bulletin board to advertise a list of awards that are to be distributed in conjunction with the 2020 UAW V-CAP Dollar Drive, the following paragraph must appear at the bottom of the notice:


UAW V-CAP is an independent political committee, created by the UAW. This committee does not ask for or accept authorization from any candidate and no candidate is responsible for its activities. UAW V-CAP uses the money it receives to make political contributions and expenditures in connection with federal, state, and local elections. Contributions to UAW V-CAP are purely voluntary and are not conditions of membership in the Union or of employment with the Company. Members have the right to refuse to contribute without fear of reprisal. All UAW members may be eligible for V-CAP raffle drawings regardless of whether they make a contribution to UAW V-CAP. Monies contributed to UAW V-CAP constitute a voluntary contribution to a joint fundraising effort by the UAW and the AFL-CIO. Contributions or gifts to UAW V-CAP are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal tax purposes.

The above language is needed to meet the requirements that we affirmatively tell the donor that the contribution is voluntary and is used for political purposes.

Any person whose name is drawn as a prize winner is personally responsible for all federal and state income taxes, as well as any other pertinent taxes.

Form 1 (White)

Financial Secretary – The local union financial secretary, upon receipt of the V-CAP Dollar Drive ticket books, should sign this form as a verification of receipt of the ticket books. The signed form should be returned to Andrea at the UAW Region 4 office. *Keep a copy for your local union files.*

Form 2 (Green)

This form should be used by the local union to record all information as to the ticket books that are distributed and the monies that are collected. The financial secretary of the local union should forward the original to Andrea at the regional office. *Keep a copy of this form for local union file records.*

Form 3 (Yellow)

For all monies collected, make checks payable to “UAW V-CAP”. Send these checks, along with the completed yellow form, to Andrea at the regional office. *Keep a copy for your local union files.*

Form 4 (White – Active V-CAP Ticket Sales Drive)

This form was implemented to comply with Federal Election Committee rules and regulations governing UAW V-CAP Ticket Drives for both active and retired members. The information requested on this form must be filled out completely for any active member who purchases \$25 or more tickets in a calendar month (active drive), and any retired member who purchases \$100 or more tickets in a calendar month. If an active or retired member purchases additional tickets on more than one occasion and reaches the \$25 active or \$100 retiree threshold, this information should also be added to this form. These completed forms must be sent in along with the yellow form and the check that goes with it to Andrea. Retain a copy for your local union records. THIS IS A FEDERAL LAW AND MUST BE FOLLOWED.

This Requirement does not pertain to those members who enrolled in automatic V-CAP check-off deductions. It only applies to the purchasers of V-CAP Dollar Drive Tickets.

Reminder: All tickets and stubs, both sold and unsold, and monies must be returned to the Region 4 office by Monday, September 14, 2020.
